- Canada is a country occupying much of North America. It is the second largest country.
- Canada is a federation composed of ten provinces and three territories, a parliamentary democracy and a constitutional monarchy, with Queen Elizabeth II (Elizabeth II) as head of state. It is a bilingual and multicultural country, with English and French as official languages. One of the most developed countries, Canada has a diversified economy, dependent on its abundant natural resources.

Education
